MOBILE PHONE POLICY

Dear Respected Parents and Carers,

Use of Mobile Phones by Students in School

Mobile phones are not permitted for students from FS to Year 6.

Key Stage 3 students may bring a mobile phone to school strictly for the purpose of contacting their parents or driver at the end of the school day. This will take place under supervised conditions only.

For Key Stage 3 students, mobile phones must remain switched off and kept in school bags at the start of the day. During morning registration, phones must be handed to the Form Tutor and will be returned at the end of the school day.

Please note the following important points:

- Mobile phones are brought to school at the student's own risk. The school accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
- Phones must be switched off and kept in the school bag until handed to the Form Tutor.
- Phones may only be used at dismissal to contact parents or drivers, under supervision.
- If a student uses a phone inappropriately — including outside official school hours but while still on school premises (e.g. taking unauthorised photos or videos,

accessing inappropriate content, or any misuse) — the phone will be confiscated immediately and the behaviour policy will be followed.

- Once confiscated, a parent will be required to come to school to collect the phone from the Principal.
