2. Summary

DAY UNIFORM

UPPER	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• White polo shirt with school logo• Foundation 1 – Year 9 = can wear short or long sleeves
LOWER	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Plain black or grey /skorts/shorts/trousers• BOYS: Foundation 1-Year 3: Plain grey or black trousers or shorts.• BOYS: Year 4- Year 9: Plain grey or black trousers• GIRLS: Foundation 1 – YEAR 3 = Plain grey skirts or skorts are allowed as long as it's below knee length and with stockings (white, grey, or maroon) underneath.• GIRLS: Year 4 – Year 9 = must wear grey trousers; Skirts/Skorts NOT allowed. This is to reflect the cultural values of Qatar.• ALL BLACK footwear remains the policy.

PE UNIFORM

- **UPPER:** Plain maroon sports t-shirt short sleeves
- **LOWER:**
 - **BOYS: Foundation 1-Year 3:** Plain maroon or black sports trousers or shorts.
 - **GIRLS: Foundation 1 – Year 3** can wear maroon or black shorts but must wear stockings underneath
 - **BOYS and GIRLS Year 4 – Year 9:** Plain maroon or black sports trousers.
- **SWIMMING**
 - Plain maroon or black short/long sleeves swim wear
 - Plain maroon or black knee-length shorts/pants swim wear

COATS/JACKETS AND FLEECES: Students can wear plain black, grey or maroon fleece, cardigan or jacket. No hoodies and no logos. Coats cannot be worn in the school building.		
LOWER	The preference is the official grey shorts or trousers from Zaks	The preference is the official grey skirts/skorts or trousers from Zaks
	Foundation 1 – Year 3 = shorts are allowed as long as it is below the knee.	Foundation 1 – Year 3 = Skirts/Skorts must be below the knee WITH stockings (plain white, grey, or maroon) underneath.
	Year 4 – Year 9 = MUST wear trousers.	Year 4 – Year 9 = MUST wear trousers

		Year 7 - Year 9 = Maroon T-shirt with Phoenix logo from Zaks (SHORT OR LONG SLEEVES)
LOWER	The preference is black, maroon or grey shorts, or sports sweatpants from Zaks	
	No logos should be visible. However, with sports shorts/trousers, it can be expected to have a small logo for the make. This should be minimal.	
	Foundation 1 - Year 3 = plain black, maroon or grey shorts	Foundation 1 - Year 3 = plain black, maroon or grey shorts WITH stockings (plain white, grey or maroon) underneath.
	Year 4 - Year 9 = plain black, maroon or grey sports pants or shorts but MUST cover the knees	Year 4 - Year 9 = plain black, maroon or grey loose fitting sports PANTS

Footwear	DAY UNIFORM <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All-black sensible and comfortable shoes/pumps/casual trainers. No white or logos must be visible at all. Soles must be plain black.
	SPORTS UNIFORM <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sensible training shoes.
Hijabs and Head Coverings	Head-coverings should remain in keeping with the uniform and be neutral in tone. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Head-covering should be plain white, black, grey or maroon. No large branding or writing should be visible.
Hair	Hair must be tied up at all times.
Make-up	Make-up is not permitted, including lip gloss and lipstick.
Nail Varnish	Nail varnish is permitted on natural nails as long as it is in neutral colour (beige, brown, cream, tan).
False Enhancements	False nails and false eyelashes are not permitted.
Accessories	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No jewelry is permitted. Earrings must be small studs only (no hoops). Necklaces are not allowed.
Other items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students can wear plain black, grey or maroon fleece, cardigan or jacket. No hoodies. No large logos. Coats cannot be worn in the school building. All students are required to have a water bottle. Any water bottle is acceptable, but for exams, we require transparent ones; available from Zaks. Phoenix-branded sun hats and caps are also available from Zaks. No hats with logos and symbols are allowed, only plain black, maroon or grey. All watches must be removed for P.E. and certain other activities as instructed by the teacher. Smart watches are NOT permitted in school.
Dress-down or Event Days	<p>The following guidance is for all members of the school community on dress-down or event days:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> National costumes / National dress should be worn correctly No tight or figure hugging clothing or short skirts or shorts to be worn No weapons, including symbolic parts of a national costume, are allowed Long, loose fitting sleeves or long head garments will need to be secured for activities such as Art or Science. Please ensure you have suitable clothes to change into for these lessons. Safety remains our paramount concern. The option to wear normal school uniform remains open to students who choose not to wear special outfits or costumes on dress-down or event days.

IMPLEMENTATION

Form tutors will monitor and record uniform compliance daily using a tracking sheet. Parents will be informed of any concerns. From FS to KS1, parents are required to remind and support their child in meeting uniform expectations. From KS2 to KS3, students are expected to take increasing responsibility for ensuring they wear the correct school uniform. If the issue occurs on three occasions, sanctions will be applied. This process supports the development of responsible citizenship for students in KS2 to KS3.

Consequences of violation of the uniform policy will follow the school behaviour policy (please refer to PPS Behaviour Policy).

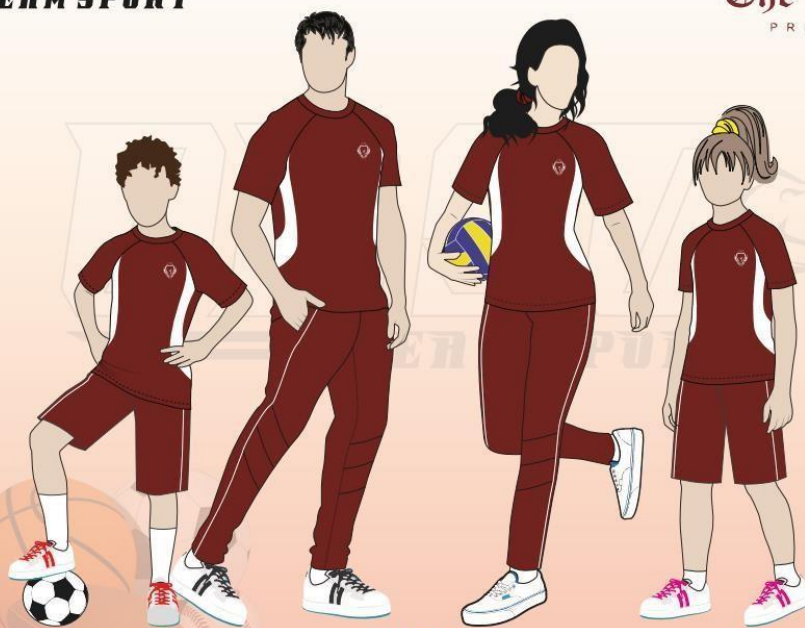
Zak's image of new day uniform:

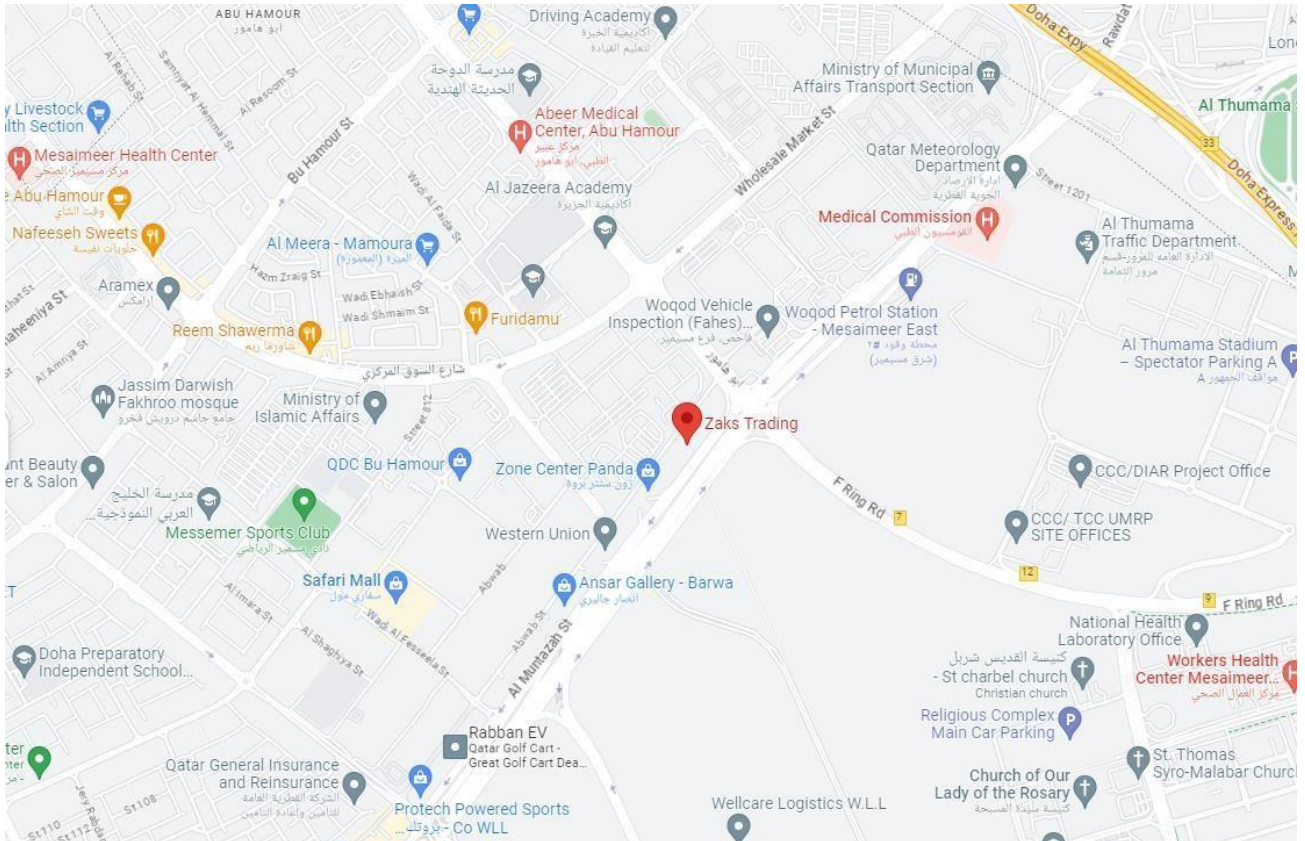
